Admissions Policy

The school governors and staff have agreed and accepted the following Admissions Policy.

In line with North Yorkshire County Policy we will offer all children a full time place in school from September 1st of the year in which they become five. In order to fulfil our duty to take into account parental preference parents may opt for a part time option, please discuss this with the Head teacher. We can be flexible to the needs of your child.

The admission limit up to the school year 2017-2018 has been set at 15 children.

Places will be allocated in line with the order of priority as follows:

- Looked After children or children with a statement of special educational needs which names the school.
- Children who live in the normal area of the school. The school's catchment area is defined as Kirkby Malzeard, Dallowgill & Laverton. (If there are not enough places for all the children priority will be given to those with brothers or sisters in school.)
- Children living outside the normal area of the school. (If there are not enough places for all the children priority will be given to those with brothers or sisters in school.)

Applications for admissions for children outside the normal area of the school will be considered providing the maximum admissions number has not been reached.

We aim to provide a quality, rich and balanced education, which meets the needs of all our children. We believe that children need to feel valued, grow in confidence and develop skills, which help them to form good relationships, develop positive attitudes and become confident learners. Children who are thought to have special educational needs will follow the same curriculum as other children within the class but may have their work differentiated to enable them to achieve the planned learning outcomes.
