#### Learning in Key Stage One

In Key stage One some learning we will cover this term will include

- Maths: Addition and subtraction of two digit numbers, and an introduction to multiplication and division structures.
- English writing: Narratives, non- fiction and poetry as well as lots of writing for pleasure.
- PSED: different rules and why we need them, looking after things and different needs.
- Science: Everyday materials.
- PE: competitive and co-operative physical activities, in a range of challenging situations.
- Art: Painting and the natural world
- Computing: Questioning and Spreadsheets
- Geography: How does the weather affect our lives
- DT: Textiles- making puppets
- Music: Pattern and pitch
- History: Holidays in the past
