Our curriculum coverage for the autumn term:

Maths: Numbers 1-100, Calculations within 20, Fluency add and subtract within 10, Addition and Subtraction of two-digit numbers, Introduction to multiplication.

PSHE: Families and friendships.

History: Travel and transport.

Science: Everyday materials.

Communications:
