
Long Term Plan – KS1

Curriculum Design Rationale

In order that our children secure the knowledge and skills needed to be successful leaners our curriculum design is underpinned by four key principles:

- 1. We always start with the child and their experiences: what they know and is familiar to them. We then move outwards until we reach the wider world and wider world views.
- 2. We always work from knowledge acquisition to application, in carefully sequenced learning journeys which build systematically on previous learning. This ensures both an inclusive and ambitious approach for all our learners.



- 3. We work to a two year plan in KS1 for Science, Geography, History, Art and DT with concepts in these running over a year, rather than terms over a series of years: This ensures that our curriculum is systematically, cohesively and robustly planned and delivered to our children in a manner in which helps them to immerse themselves in a subject for deeper learning. (This also negates the effect of the impact of changing class structures). It also allows us to make pertinent links between interdisciplinary knowledge across our long term plan to allow the children to frame their learning within a larger concept in order to help them to retain this.
- 4. We work to a two-year plan for PSHE, Computing, French, Music, PE and RE
